

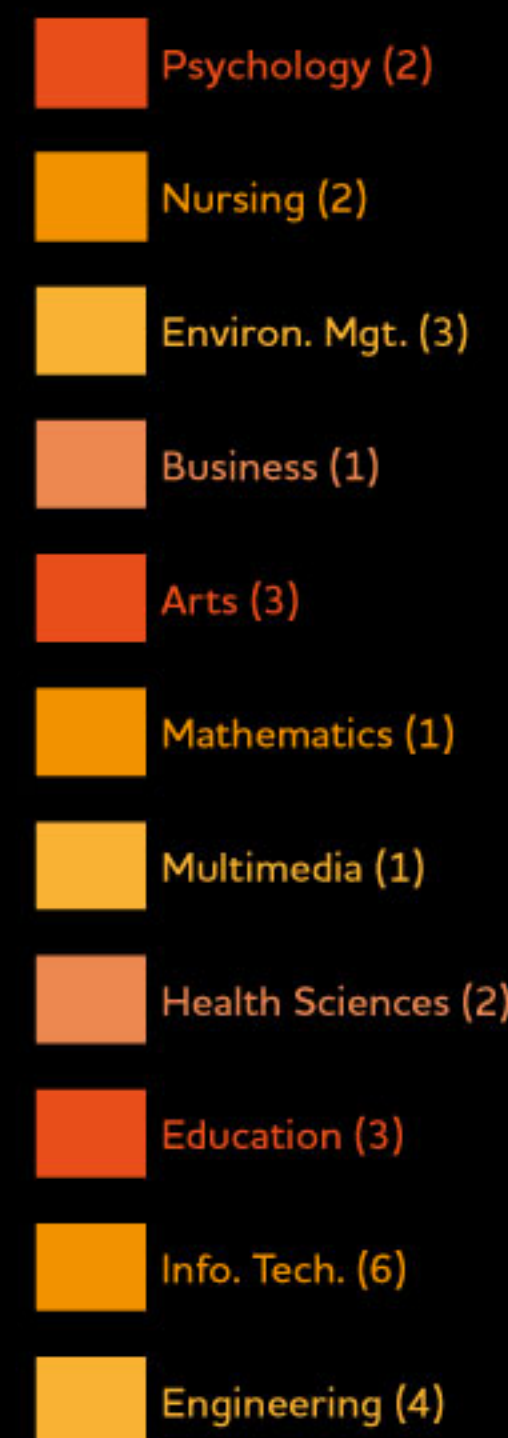

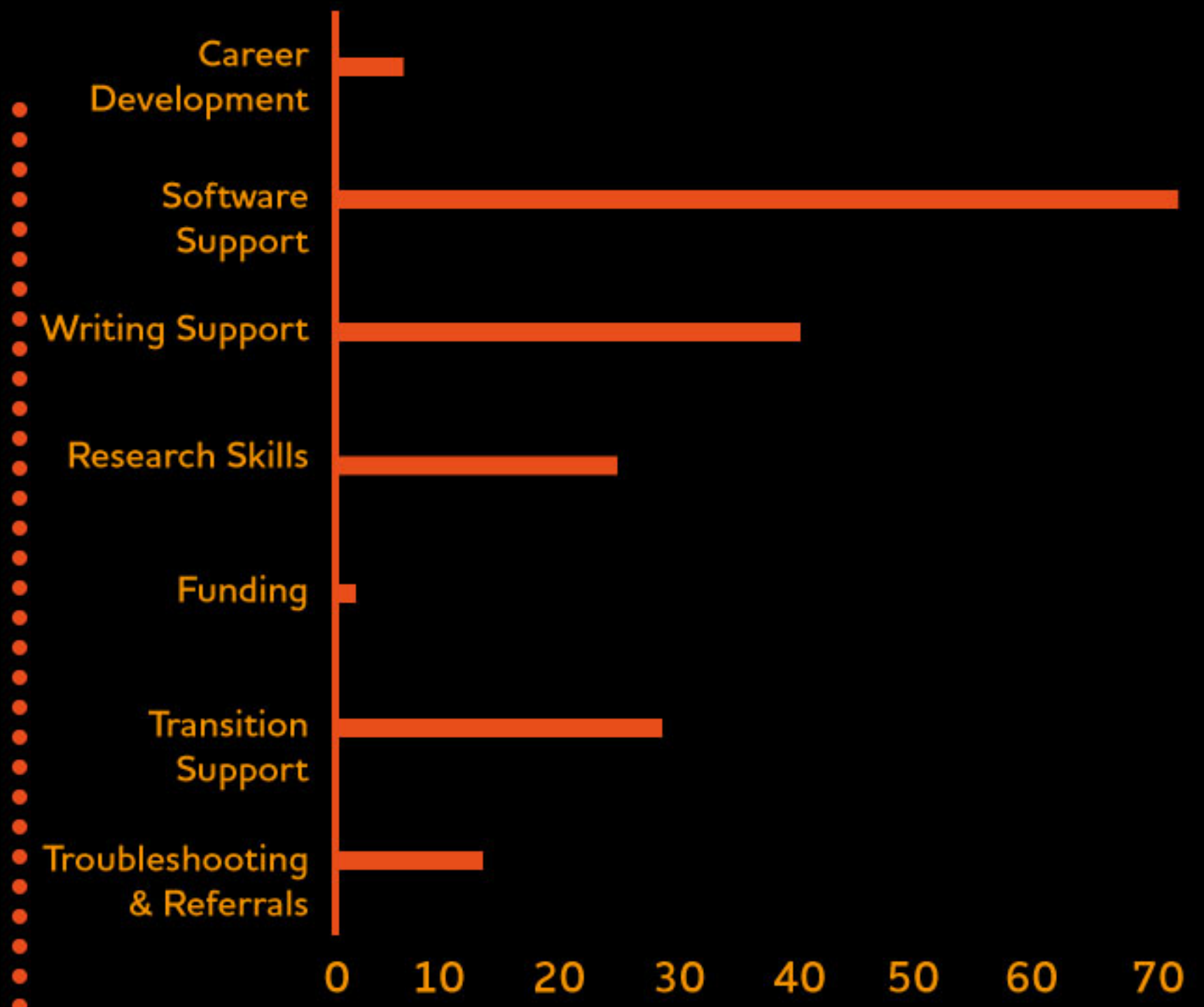
What fields of study are the SOAR Ambassadors in?



Providing the ECU research community with **Support, Opportunities, Advice & Resources**

The SOAR Centre is a peer-to-peer service run by and for ECU's Higher Degree by Research (HDR) and Honours candidates. Ten HDR candidates are employed as SOAR Ambassadors every semester, providing casual employment for those researchers and a central support service for their peers.

The centre is concerned with lessening isolation for all HDR and Honours candidates, by offering cultural, academic and campus transition support. International candidates new to Perth can chat with SOAR Ambassadors who may have also experienced the challenges of adapting to a new culture. Academic and campus support is also available for those who are new to the research community.
