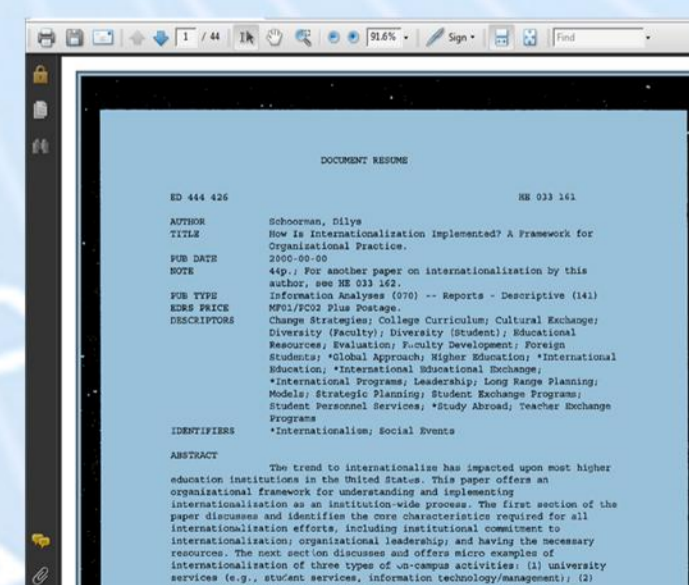
2 Drop and Store References in

Automatic export from library databases, Library One Search or Google Scholar

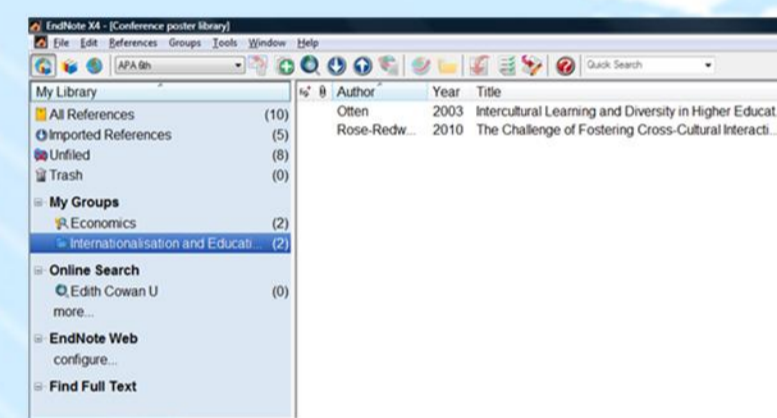


Import using PDF metadata

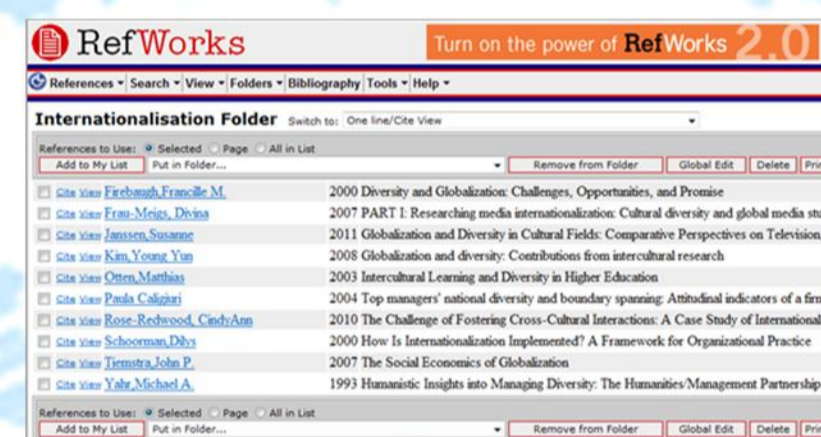


Export to RefWorks from a shared folder

EndNote or EndNote Web groups or smart groups



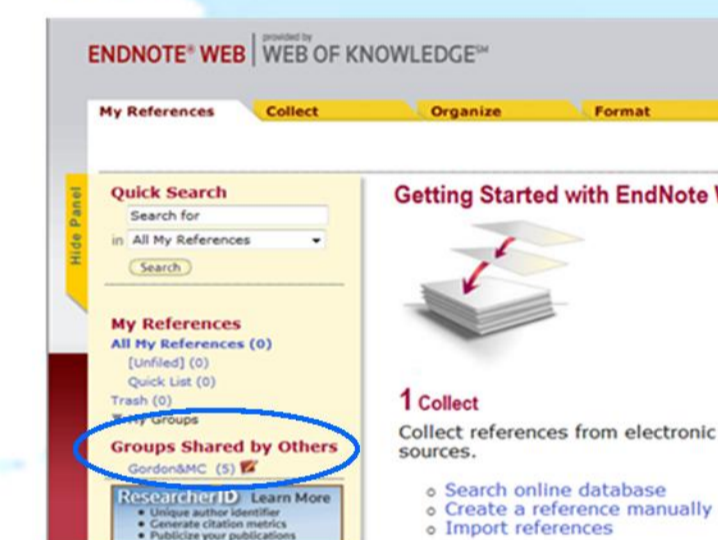
RefWorks folders

References can be sorted by date, author or title

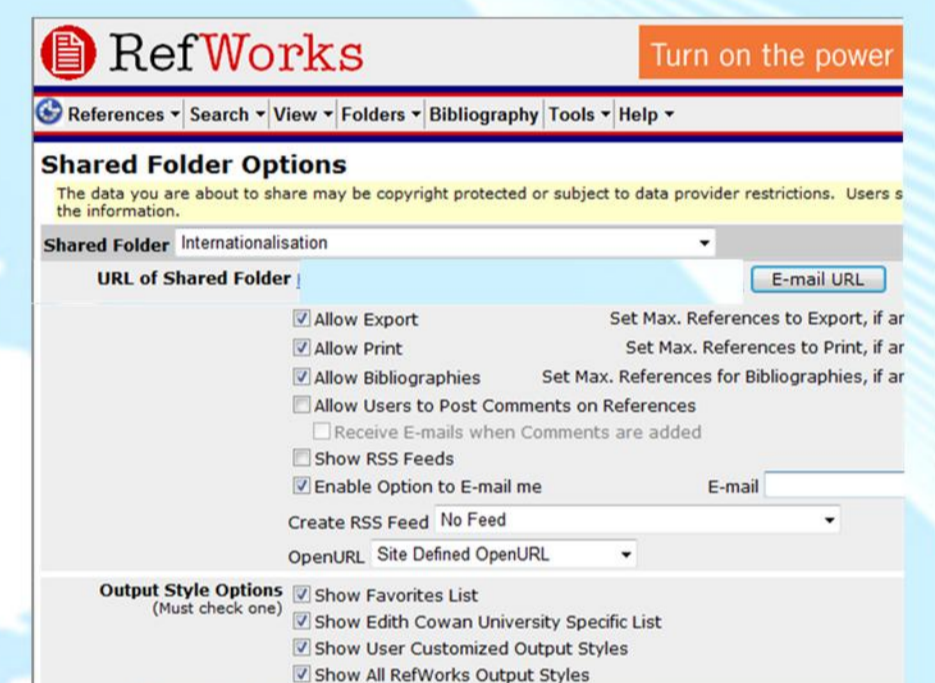
4 Share References with Colleagues

References can be exchanged with colleagues around the world, using **EndNote**, **EndNote Web** or **RefWorks**

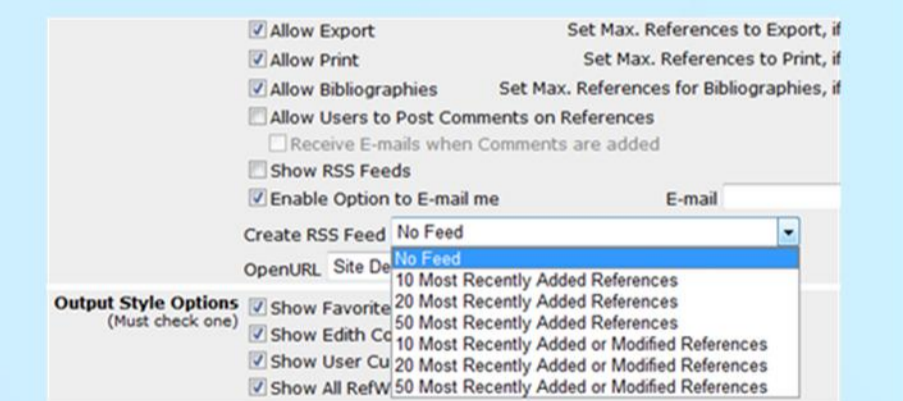
Use **EndNote Web** to share groups, Use **RefWorks** to email access changes instantly online a URL to a shared folder



Use **EndNote** to email a compressed version of libraries or selected references



RefWorks can provide updates to shared folders via an RSS feed
