What is digital assessment?

Future generations will look back at current assessment practices and wonder why it took so long to replace pen and paper assessment with quality digital forms of assessment. Digitization of the assessment process, from student work to the recording of marks is occurring now but haphazardly and is often only a replication of the paper assessment process. The desired goals and aims of learning have rarely been fully achieved with pen and paper assessment.
