

Enhancing Employability of ECU Graduates:

Curriculum 2012 and internationalising the student experience

A key feature of *Curriculum 2012 and Beyond* is 'Employability'. This includes graduates who can work in an international context and demonstrate international perspectives as professionals and citizens. The *Internationalising the Student Experience* project aims to promote this outcome by building the capacity of ECU staff to plan, design, implement, deliver and evaluate a curriculum that advances the learning experiences of *all* ECU undergraduates. ECU documents, higher education research, and other universities' websites have informed this project. Data was obtained through face-to-face interviews with ECU staff and international and domestic students as well as written statements taken from them. The findings of this project highlight the need at ECU to actively and purposely internationalise the student experience through a 'curriculum' that: includes globalised content, is culturally inclusive, is culturally sensitive, and introduces students to academic literacy and conventions.

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
